M/s Aggarwal Traders Vs Balwinder Singh

The accused surrendered before this Court today in pursuant to the bailable warrants issued by this Court.

The offence in question is bailable in nature and as such, the accused has a right to be admitted to bail. Accordingly, the accused is ordered to be admitted to bail on furnishing her bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. The accused made a statement as under:

“Stated that I request the Hon'ble Court to kindly release me on furnishing personal bond today and to grant me an adjournment for furnishing surety bonds as I am unable to furnish the surety bonds today. I undertake to furnish the surety bonds on the next date of hearing”.

Heard. Request allowed in the interest of justice. The accused is permitted to furnish personal bond today. Personal bond furnished, which has been attested and accepted.

Heard. Notice of accusation served upon the accused to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

A perusal of the case file would reveal that from the contents of the complaint it is made out that detailed recording of evidence is required in the present case and in case, the case of the complainant is proved against the accused, then higher punishment is likely to be imposed on the accused. As such, the present case cannot be proceeded with as a summary trial.

In light of the foregoing facts, the case is adjourned to **16.08.2023** for the post-notice evidence of the complainant and for furnishing the surety bonds by the accused.
