The complainant has filed the present case in accordance with E filing rules 2021 framed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, New Delhi u/s 7 of the Delhi High Court Act 1996.

Ld. Counsel for the complainant submits that the case is filed within limitation and ECS mandate has also been filed along with the complaint.

In view of the submissions made and the proviso to Section 223 (1) of BNSS, 2023, ***let Court notice be issued to proposed accused*** to appear before this court to argue on the aspect of cognizance on filing of PF within 15 days from today, returnable for NDOH.

Ld. counsel for the complainant is at liberty to effect the service of notice through all permissible modes including whatsapp and email.

However, it is made clear that this notice under proviso to Section 223 (1) of BNSS, 2023 it not be treated as summons and the proposed accused is entitled to appear either in person or through a counsel.

In case, the proposed accused fails to appear after service of notice, the Court shall proceed to take cognizance in the matter in his/her absence.

Put up for appearance of the proposed accused/further proceedings on 18.03.2026.

Court notice be also issued dasti for service on the proposed accused.
