3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioner has been granted bail by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.789/2026 by order dated:20.04.2026 with a condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily



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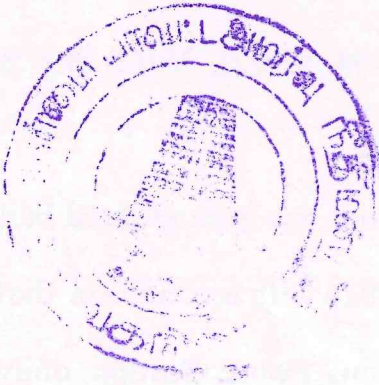

Further, the modification petition has been already allowed in CrI.M.P.1098/2026 by order dated:22.05.2026 with a condition that the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police station, weekly once on every Saturday morning at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. As per the direction of this Court, the petitioner had complied the order to till date. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is abiding the condition from 24.05.2026 and moreover, he is aged about 60 years and due to his age factor, he is unable to abide the condition imposed by this Court. Hence, the petitioner has came up with this petition to modify the order imposed on bail by this Court.

3. Considering the reason stating the petitioner seeking for relaxation. This Court finds that the investigation has been completed, charge-sheet has been laid before the concerned Judicial Magistrate. Considering the above circumstances, this Court is inclined to relax the condition.

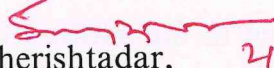
