The petition came up for final hearing before me on 11.03.2026 in the presence of Thiru.S.Valmeganathan, B.A.,B.L., learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused and Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, I made the following.

ORDER

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner U/S. 480 BNSS for seeking bail. The petitioner was alleged to have been committed an offence under Sections 331(4), 305(a) BNS.

2. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petition is falsely implicated in the case and prayed for bail.

3. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor contended that the accused person shall not be released on bail referring to tamper witnesses and investigation yet not completed. Hence bail may not be granted.

4. I have heard the learned counsels of both sides and perused records, Since the Investigation completed on the side of prosecution, the further custody of accused person is

not necessary. Moreover the prosecution has not explained the reason for custody of an accused person at this stage of prosecution. It is seen that the accused person was remanded to judicial custody on 16.12.2025 and the accused person is in incarceration for 86 days. Moreover, the co-accused person is released on bail by the Hon'ble Principal District court, Sivagangai in CrI.M.P.No.206/2026, dated:29.01.2026. Having regard to the said fact and circumstance of the case. I am inclined to grant bail on the following conditions.

- (a) That the petitioner/accused person shall execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- before the court with two sureties like sum to the satisfaction of this Hon'ble Court.
- (b) After release, the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police daily once at 10.00 A.M for 20 days.

5. Accordingly, the petition is allowed.
