The petition came up for final hearing before me on 12.03.2026 in the presence of Thiru.S.Valmeganathan, B.A., B.L., learned Counsel for the Petitioner/ Accused and Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, I made the following.

**ORDER**

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioners U/S. 480 BNSS for seeking bail. The petitioner is alleged to has been committed an offence under Sections 309(6) BNS.

2. The petitioner/accused stated that the petitioner he is innocent and he is falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner has undertaken that he will abide any condition that may be imposed on him. The petitioner/accused has also undertaken that will not tamper the witnesses or hamper the process of the prosecution. The petitioner/ accused further submitted that he is ready and willing to furnish adequate

and substantial sureties to ensure his attendance and has prayed this Court to release him on bail.

3. Notice was sent to Assistant Public Prosecutor and police. Reply received from the Assistant Public Prosecutor/Police. In the reply of Police and Assistant Public Prosecutor it is stated that the investigation is still pending and indulge in similar kind of offence if he released on bail. Hence, at this stage the prosecution has strongly objection for granting bail to the petitioner.

4. On perusal of case records, it is seen that the petitioner/accused was arrested and remanded judicial custody on 24.02.2026 for the offence u/s.309(6) BNS and on considering the facts and circumstances of this case and also considering the police and Assistant Public Prosecutor reply that the investigation is still pending and the petitioner may tamper the witnesses if he is released on bail. Hence this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/ accused at this stage.

**In the result, this petition is Dismissed.**
