(CNR No. MHBI0100-2448-2026)**Rakesh s/o. Sahebrao Lokhande****Vs.****The State of Maharashtra + 1****ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

1] This is an application filed by the applicant/accused to release him on anticipatory bail under section 482 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 in crime No. 188/2026, punishable under sections 74, 333, 115(2), 352, 351(2), 189(2), 190 of the B.N.S., and punishable under sections 8,17 POCSO Act which is registered in the Ambhora police station, Dist. Beed.

2] Applicant submitted that respondent No.2 lodged report at Ambhora Police Station. As she is residing with her husband, son, daughter and daughter-in-law and in-laws. On 07.06.2026 at about 06.00 am, she, her husband and her mother-in-law had been to field, her father-in-law had been to bring milk. Her son had been to field. Only daughter and daughter-in-law were present in the house. At about 08.00 am., one unknown boy had been to collect hair. At that time victim told him that there is no hair to sale. However, he entered into the compound. While victim was going towards bathroom then said unknown boy caught hold her hand. Therefore, she screamed. Then

victim's brother came there and he gave 2-3 slap to the accused. While going he threatened to kill him. At about 02.00 pm., again said boy and other 5 persons came on motorcycles. They caught hold hand of her daughter. Other persons instigated the applicant. At that time, in the house, daughter and daughter-in-law were present. Respondent went there. They assaulted her and her in-laws by means of legs and fist blows. Thereafter, neighbours came there and separated them. Thereafter, accused persons ran away. After enquiry, she came to know that applicant was the same person who came in the morning. Then she lodged report.

3] Applicant submitted that he is innocent. He is falsely implicated in this case. FIR is lodged against unknown persons. There is no allegations regarding penetrative or aggravated sexual assault. There is no specific overt act causing any grievous injury. Co-accused namely Suraj Kshirsagar has already granted bail. Remaining co-accused are juveniles. Therefore, submitted that on the ground of parity, he is entitled for bail. There is no recovery from this applicant. He has no criminal antecedents. He will not tamper the prosecution evidence. Therefore, prayed to grant him anticipatory bail.

4] APP has filed say and submitted that there is prima facie case against the applicant. There is active participation of this applicant in this offence. If he is released on bail, he will pressurize the complainant and witnesses. He will again commit such type of offence. Investigation is in progress. Therefore, prayed to reject the application.

5] Heard the Ld. advocate for the applicant and Ld. APP for the State.

6] After gone through the record, it is found that there is a case accused has caught hold hand of the victim. Thereafter again came to the spot and again insulted modesty of the victim and beaten to the complainant with legs and blows. There is apprehension that again accused will commit such type of offence. Considering the act of the accused, he caught hold the hands of the victim and beaten to her mother. No any weapon is used in this case. Considering the nature of offence, bail can be granted by imposing terms and conditions. Hence, following order.

ORDER

1] In the event of arrest applicant/accused **Rakesh s/o. Sahebrao Lokhande** in crime No.188/2026 for the offences punishable under sections 74, 333, 115(2), 352, 351(2), 189(2), 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and under sections 8, 17 of the POCSO Act, registered with Police Station Ambhora, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty Thousand Rupees only) with one or two solvent sureties in the like amount.

2] The applicant shall attend the concerned police station as and when required by the Investigating Officer in writing.

3] The applicant shall not contact the victim in any manner and not to enter in the village till disposal of the case.

4] The applicant shall not tamper with the evidence or attempt to influence or contact the complainant, witnesses or any person concerned with the case in any manner.

5] The applicant shall keep the investigating officer informed of his current address and mobile contact numbers, and/or change of residence or mobile details, if any, from time to time.

6] The application stands disposed of.
