The complainant has filed the present case in accordance with E filing rules 2021 framed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, New Delhi u/s 7 of the Delhi High Court Act 1996.

Complainant is directed to bring all the original documents pertaining to the complaint, including the dishonored cheque/s (ECS Mandate), dishonor memo, Legal Demand Notice, dispatch receipt (postal receipt) and service proof (tracking report), reply if any etc., signed original complaint, its supporting affidavit and attested affidavit of pre-summoning evidence **for inspection as and when required by the court as per rule 10 for on-line electronic filing framed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi u/s 7 of the Delhi High Court Act 1996 (Act 26 of 1999)** and the same be returned back to the complainant of the present case after due inspection for keeping the same in safe custody of the complainant as all the above mentioned original documents are a pre-requisite of taking cognizance and passing of summoning order.

In view of the proviso to Section 223(1) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, let notice be issued to proposed accused to appear before this court to argue on the aspect of cognizance on filing of PF within 15 days from today, returnable for the NDOH.

Ld. Counsel for the complainant is at liberty to effect the service of notice through all permissible modes (including WhatsApp and Email).

However, it is made clear that this notice under proviso to Section 223(1) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is not to be treated as summons and the accused is entitled to appear either in person or through a counsel.

In case the accused fails to appear after service of notice, the court shall proceed to take cognizance in the matter in his/her absence.

Put up for appearance of the proposed accused/further proceedings on **07.05.2026**.

Complainant is directed to file tracking report on NDOH.
