Let the legible copies of charge sheet and other relevant documents be supplied to the accused against acknowledgment u/s 207 Cr.PC.

At this stage, accused wants to plead guilty for offence u/s 223(a) BNS. He has been warned about consequences of pleading guilty but still the accused persisted with his plea.

I am satisfied that accused is pleading guilty voluntarily after understanding implication of same.

Matter has been tried summarily. Vide STR No. 307 dated 24.03.2026, accused stands convicted for the offence punishable u/s 223(a) BNS.

Ld. APP requested for maximum punishment to the convict.

Per contra, it is submitted by convict that lenient view may be taken against him as he is poor, first time offender and remorseful of his conduct. In facts and circumstances of case, convict is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 500/- in default SI 01 day. Fine paid.
