Perused the records. The Petitioner/ P.W.3 Thiru.Pulithevapandiyan has filed this petition seeking refund of the amount of Rs.300/- (M.O.1) in pursuance of the notice issued by this Court regarding disposal of case properties.

It is seen from the records that in Special C.C.No.61 of 2014, this Court earlier pronounced judgment on 22.09.2017. Aggrieved by the said judgment, (A1)Thiru.Sudhandhiram preferred an appeal before the Hon'ble High Court, Madurai Bench in **Cri.A.(MD) No.402 of 2017**. The Hon'ble High Court, by judgment **dated 19.09.2023**, allowed the appeal and set aside the judgment of this Court, thereby acquitting the accused. Further, on enquiry with the Inspector of Police, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Sivagangai, it has been reported that no further appeal has been preferred before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the case has been treated as **"Not Fit for Appeal"**.

In view of the above circumstances and after expiry of the appeal period, this Court had issued notice directing P.W.3 Pulithevapandiyan to appear before this Court and receive the M.O.1 amount of Rs.300/-.
