This petition was taken on file before this court and numbered as Crl.M.P.No.152 of 2026 and came up for final hearing before me on



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24.06.2026 in the presence of Thiru.AV.Rajendran the learned counsel for the complainant and Thiru.L.Balasubramanian the learned counsel for the defence and upon hearing the arguments and perusing all the connected materials, having stood over for consideration till this day, this court do the following:

ORDER

Petitioner in petition states that the Complainant has filed a case of cheque fraud against me, alleging that I had taken a loan of Rs.4,00,000/- from him and had paid it in 6 months. and then paid the principal amount of Rs.4,00,000/- and interest of Rs.25,000/- by cashing the cheque No.027283 for Rs.4,25,000/-,and that i had presented it it for collection and it was not cashed. I have filed a counter – claim in the case by stating that I did not take the said loan and that the respondent did not pay the said cheque for Rs.4,25,000/-by cashing the cheque to the complainant. In the above case, after the hearing of the petitioner shanmugam's side was over and there was on 12.03.2026. for my sides hearing on wednesday. 11.03.2026 at 8.44Pm, the above shanmugam called my cell phone. The complainant was registered in this regard on 08.05.2026.I sent a complainant by post , After that since, no investigation was conducted.I went to the sakkottai Police Station in person on 16.05.2026 and filed a complainant.



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Respondent in Counter states that the petitioner said that I threatened him over the phone at the sakkottai Police station and that the petitioner filed a complaint at the sakkottai police station on 15.05.2026 in this regard. The petitioner and I appeared for questioning at the sakkottai Police station regarding the complaint. During the Police Station inquiry, I have stated that I do not have the pronote or cheque belonging to the petitioner. I have also filed the same in writing at the police station.

By considering the submissions of both parties. It is clear that the Police Complaint was made after the commencement of the trial in the present case. Which has no bearing on the present trial. Separate recourse is available for the petitioner. The said Police complaint has nothing to do with the present case. No sufficient reason submitted. Entering this petition will cause further delay in the present trial. Therefore petition is dismissed.
