This petition is coming on 02.04.2026 before this court in the presence of Thiru.L.Balasubramanian who is appearing for the complainant and upon perusing this case records and having stood over for consideration till this day and this Court has passed the following

**ORDER**

1.The present complaint has been filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. The complainant has now moved the present application under Section 257 of the Criminal Procedure Code, seeking permission to withdraw the complaint.

2. It is stated in the application that the dispute between the complainant and the accused has been amicably settled. It is further averred that the cheque amount involved in the present case has already been paid by the accused to the complainant, and therefore, no grievance survives. On these grounds, the complainant has prayed for permission to withdraw the complaint.

3. The application is supported by an affidavit of the complainant. On perusal of the affidavit and the contents of the application, this Court is



satisfied that the dispute has been settled voluntarily and that sufficient grounds exist for allowing the withdrawal of the complaint.

4. Accordingly, permission under Section 257 of the Criminal Procedure Code is hereby granted. The application stands allowed. The complaint is dismissed as withdrawn. Consequently, the accused is acquitted of the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

5. Ordered accordingly.
