This petition came up for final hearing before me on 08.06.2026 in the presence of Thiru.M.Veeramuthu, advocate for Petitioner/Accused and Assistant Public Prosecutor for the state and upon hearing the arguments on both sides and perusing the materials records this court delivered the following:

ORDER

1. This Petition filed U/s.437 Cr.P.C seeking to release the petitioner on bail. Notice given to learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and respondent police.

2. The petitioner is facing charges U/s. 4(1)(A), 4(1)(B) TNP Amendment Act 2024 in Crime No.217/2026 of Thiruppuvanam P.S. Notice given to respondent on 03.06.2026 and reply received on 08.06.2026

3. The contention of the petition stated that the petitioner is innocent, he did not commit any offence alleged in this case and the petitioner is in Judicial custody from 18.05.2026

4. Opposing to grant bail, the respondent police has submitted that the investigation is pending at the initial stage. The gravity of offence is grave in nature. In the circumstances, if the petitioner is released on bail, he would commit the similar offence, abscond, not be traceable and evade the process of law and there may be chance for tampering and hampering the witnesses. Hence sought for dismissal of the petition.

5. This court has considered the rival submissions made on either side. Considering the above said aspects, nature of offence, having regard to the detention of the accused person is in the judicial custody from 18.05.2026 to till date. Hence considering the facts & circumstances, the petition is allowed on following conditions:

- i) The Petitioner/accused Photograph along with aadhar card or Bank passbook should be affixed to ensure the identity of the accused and execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- together with two sureties each for like sum and both sureties should affix their photo and left thumb impression in the surety bond.
- ii) The petitioner shall appear before this court on receiving summon.
- iii) The petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station at 10.00 AM for 30 days.
- iv) Further the petitioner shall not commit the similar offence in future.
