On today, this petition coming for final hearing before me on 14.07.2026 in the presence of Advocate Mr. S. Ramanathan for the Petitioner and Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent. Upon perusing the records and having stood over for consideration, this court delivers the following.

ORDER

Petition filed u/s.483(1)(b) of BNSS in Cr.No.41/2026, u/s.126(2), 296(b), 118(1), 64, 62, 109 BNS Act to relax the condition imposed by this court in its order in Crl.MP.No.771/2026, dated on 14.07.2026. On perusing the records and reply submitted by



the prosecution, From the perusal of records it is seen that accused person previously signed before Respondent Police Station and after that was ordered on 01.06.2026, and from then the petitioner signing before this Respondent P.S. The petitioner is complying with condition regularly for the past days from 07.07.2026. The petitioner has got permanent residencecy and he will not abscond. The petitioner undertakes to appear regularly in the forth coming hearings of the above said case in this court. The petitioner stated that they are doing Coolie work and due to appearance before the police station to sign, they couldn't go for work and seek for relaxation of the above condition. Moreover he has also signed before the respondent police for 33 days. Hence, on considering the nature of offence and obedience of the accused person, this court is inclined to relax the condition. Hence, prayed to fully relax the condition imposed over the petitioner/Accused. It is seen that the accused appeared and signed before the Respondent P.S for untill further as per the condition imposed by this court. The investigation almost over. Hence, on considering his obedience, this court inclined to relax the condition. Further the accused is directed to appear before this court on receipt of summons.
