

CIS No. CM.237 of 2026 Ram Niwas etc. Vs. State of Haryana

Present: Sh. Amarjeet Rana, Advocate for the applicants.

Ld. GP has appeared for the State/JD no.1. Authority letter has been filed on behalf of the respondent no.2 by Sh. Anil Kumar Ranga. Power of attorney on behalf of the respondent no. 3 has been filed by Sh. Amit Balyan, Advocate. Service of the respondents has been completed.

An application for impleading the Lrs of petitioner no. 3 Rajender has been moved by applicants Laxmi and Ajay Rana. Reply to the said application has not been filed. The application is supported by affidavit of Laxmi LR of deceased Rajender son of Rati Ram.

Today, joint statement made by Panmeshwari widow of Rati Ram and Komal daughter of Rajender has been recorded wherein they do not have any objection if their share be given to Laxmi (widow) of Rajender.

In view of the above explained position, the said application in hand is allowed and the applicants Laxmi, Ajay Rana, Komal and Panmeshwari are impleaded as legal representatives of deceased/petitioner no. 3 Rajender son of Rati. However, compensation of the share of Komal and Panmeshwari be released in favour of Laxmi widow of Rajender.

Ld. Counsel for the respondent no. 3 has pointed out that payment of compensation has already been deposited with the respondent no.2 i.e. DRO. In view of the deposit of compensation with respondent no.2, the same be released to the applicants as per their share along with interest upto date immediately. Copy of this order be sent to the respondent no. 2 for compliance. Hence, this civil miscellaneous application stands disposed of. File be consigned to the record room, after due compliance.
