condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., for 30 days. As per the direction of this Court, the petitioner had complied the condition for the past 16 days. Hence, the petitioner had came up with this petition to relax the order imposed on bail by this Court.

4. The respondent filed an objection stating that the petitioner is abiding the condition from 25.02.2026 to 12.03.2026 for the past 16 days. However, if the condition is relaxed, there is a likelihood of the petitioner committing further offences in future.

5. By considering the submissions of the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner had complied with the condition from 25.02.2026 to 12.03.2026 for the past 16 days, this court is inclined to modify the condition and the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station weekly once on every Monday at 10.00 a.m., for 08 weeks.

In the result, this condition is modified and the condition imposed by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.312/2026 dated 13.02.2026 **is modified and the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station, weekly once on every Monday at 10.00 a.m., for 08 weeks, thereafter**
