O R D E R

This is the petition filed by the petitioner seeking modification of the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.1598/2025 dated 01.08.2025, by directing the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni, to hand over the deposited original sale deed to the Petitioner/Accused No.1.

2. The petitioner and the defacto complainant are husband and wife. While considering the anticipatory bail application in Crl.M.P No.1598 of 2025 dated 01.08.2025, this court was pleased to impose a condition by depositing the original sale deed standing in the name of the jointly standing in the name of the petitioner and the respondent was ordered to be retained by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni, on the said original document being produced while entertaining the sureties and the original document is now available in the custody of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni, concerned in Crime No.286 of 2025.

3. Now, subsequently, with regard to the other proceedings pending before the Domestic Violence Act in D.V.C. No.17 of 2025, before the learned Judicial Magistrate direction to register FIR in Crl.M.P. No.4112 of 2025 was also pending. Now the parties, namely the petitioner and the defacto complainant, have arrived at a settlement and the matter is amicably settled between the parties before mediation. Pursuant to the said mediation settlement arrived, the petitioner had furnished 46 sovereigns of gold jewels returned to the defacto complainant and the defacto complainant in turn had paid Rs.20,95,000/-. Both the parties have also filed a mutual consent divorce application before the

Subordinate Court, Uthamapalayam and numbered as H.M.O.P. No.98 of 2026.

The same is posted for hearing on 27.04.2026.

4. Now, the petitioner and the respondent sought for return of the sale deed originally retained in the custody of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni for the purpose of execution of release deed, by one of the co-owners, namely, the petitioner, in favor of the defacto complainant's daughter, wife of the petitioner in order to comply with one of the conditions arrived in terms of the settlement, the original document is required to be returned to the petitioner. Both the parties present today along with their counsel and by confirming the terms of the settlement, the original document, namely the sale deed Doc. No.9418/2023 dated 23.09.2023, now available in the custody of Judicial Magistrate, Theni is ordered to be returned to the petitioner on execution of the release deed by the petitioner in favor of the defacto complainant's daughter Mrs. Sivaharini, as per the terms of the agreement. The original document shall be handed over to the petitioner.

5. In furtherance to the said settlement, it was also agreed by the parties that the case instituted by the petitioner's wife, Sivaharini, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni, concerned in Crime Nos. 286 of 2025 and 404 of 2025, both concerned to P.C. Patti Police Station, the complainant agreed to withdraw the

case on being satisfied with the terms of the agreement/compromise arrived, this petition is disposed of.

In the result, this petition is disposed of by modifying the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.1598/2025 dated 01.08.2025 by directing the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni to hand over the deposited original sale deed in Doc. No.9418/2023 dated 23.09.2023 to the Petitioner/Accused No.1 for execution of release deed in favour of the petitioner's wife.
