The petition coming on this day for final hearing before me in the presence of Thiru. S. Kajamydeen, Advocate for the petitioners and Thiru. P. Baskaran, Public Prosecutor for the State, after hearing both sides and perusing the written reply submitted by the respondent and records, this court delivers the following ...

ORDER

1. This petition has been filed for extension of time for complying the conditional order imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.No.426/2026 dated 04.03.2026.

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2. The offences alleged punishable u/s.85, 296(b) and 316(2) BNS.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners/accused has contended that the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this Court as per order in Crl.M.P.No.426/2026 dated 04.03.2026. As per the order, the petitioners shall surrender before the **Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur** within 15 days of the above order. The petitioners stated that they could not able to surrender before the **Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur** within the specified time. So that, the petitioners had come forward with the second petition and pray for extension of further time to comply the conditions of the anticipatory bail order in Crl.M.P.No.426/2026 dated 04.03.2026.

4. The petitioners/accused had been granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 04.03.2026 as per the order in Crl.M.P.No.426/2026 and they were directed to surrender before the **Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur**. But, the petitioners/accused had not surrendered within the time stipulated. The counsel for the petitioners had argued that, they could not able to arrange sureties within the period, hence they could not surrender within 15 days in order to abide by the conditions.

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5. By considering the submissions of the parties and the fact that the petitioners were already considered anticipatory bail by this Court and they have not surrendered within the prescribed time. Hence, this Court is inclined to extend the time for surrender before the **Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur** within one week, from this date.

In the result, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are permitted to surrender before the **Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur** within one week from today and they are permitted to abide by the conditions already imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.426/2026 dated 04.03.2026.
