2. The offences alleged are punishable u/s.296(b), 115(2), 351(3) BNS and 4 of TNPHW Act.

3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioners have been granted bail by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.415/2026 by order dated 04.03.2026 with a condition that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the Devathanapatti Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., and 5.00 p.m., for 30 days. As per the direction of this Court, the petitioners had complied the condition for the past 17 days. Hence, the petitioners had came up with this petition to relax the order imposed on bail by this Court.

4. The respondent filed an objection stating that the petitioners are abiding the condition from 10.03.2026 to 26.03.2026 for the past 17 days. However, if the condition is modified, there is a likelihood of the petitioners committing further offences in future.

5. By considering the submissions of the parties and considering the fact that the petitioners had complied with the condition from 10.03.2026 to 26.03.2026 for the past 17 days, this court is inclined to modify the condition and the petitioners are directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station weekly once on every Monday at 10.00 a.m., for 12 weeks.



In the result, this condition is modified and the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.415/2026 dated 04.03.2026 **is modified and the petitioners are directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station weekly once on every Monday at 10.00 a.m., for 12 weeks**, thereafter they should appear before the Court concerned on receipt of summon except the above modification, the other conditions imposed holds good.
