The petition coming on this day for final hearing before me in the presence of Thiru. D. Manikandan, Advocate for the petitioners and on perusal of the written reply filed by the respondent police and the records available on file, this court delivers the following ...

ORDER

1. This petition has been filed u/s.483(b) of B.N.S.S., to modify the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.988/2026 dated 12.06.2026.

2. The offences alleged are punishable u/s.191(2), 126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 351(2) BNS and 4 of TNPHW Act.

3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioners have been granted bail by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.988/2026 by order dated 12.06.2026 with a condition that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., for 30 days. Further, he submitted that the petitioners are college students studying at Government Arts and Science College, Virudhunagar. Therefore, it is

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difficult for them to appear before the respondent police on a daily basis. Hence, the petitioners have come forward with the present petition seeking modification of the condition imposed by this Court while granting bail, by permitting them to appear before the Inspector of Police, Virudhunagar Bazaar Police Station.

4. The respondent police strongly opposed the petition, contending that the petitioners have failed to comply with the condition imposed by this Court and have not adhered to the same even for a single day.

5. Heard the submissions. As rightly pointed out by the respondent police, the petitioners have not complied with the condition imposed in the bail order even for a single day. This Court is of the view that the petitioners, having failed to abide by the condition imposed in the bail order, cannot seek its modification without first demonstrating compliance with the said condition. Therefore, no sufficient cause has been made out for interference with the earlier order. Accordingly, this petition stands dismissed.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
