ORDER

1. This petition has been filed u/s.483(b) of B.N.S.S., to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.864/2026 dated 09.06.2026.

2. The offences alleged are punishable u/s.296(b), 118(1) and 351(3) BNS.

3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.864/2026 by order dated 09.06.2026 with a condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., and 5.00 p.m., until further orders. As per the direction of this Court, the petitioners had complied the condition for the past 31 days. Hence, the

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petitioner had came up with this petition to relax the order imposed on bail by this Court.

4. The respondent filed an objection stating that the petitioner abiding the condition from 12.06.2026 to 12.07.2026 for the past 31 days. However, if the condition is relaxed, there is a likelihood of the petitioner committing further offences in future.

5. Considering the reasons stated in the petition seeking for relaxation and considering the fact that the petitioner is complying with the condition from 12.06.2026 to 12.07.2026 for the past 31 days, this court is inclined to modify the condition and the petitioner should appear before the Court concerned on receipt of summon.

In the result, this condition is modified and the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.864/2026 dated 09.06.2026 is modified **and the petitioner should appear before the court concerned on receipt of summon** except the above modification, the other conditions imposed holds good.
