

**Criminal Misc. Case No. 774 of 2026**

**Order No. 02**

**04.08.2026**

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, filed by the accused/petitioner namely; **Sujoy Banerjee**, praying for anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest, in connection with Pancha P.S Case No. 60 of 2026 dated 24.07.2026 under Sections 143/147/148/149/447/354/506/171F/34 of IPC, vide G.R. Case No. 1436 of 2026.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is moved by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused petitioner.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta. The present accused petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is a senior citizen, aged about 70 years and is suffering from multiple age-related ailments requiring constant medical attention. Accordingly, Ld. Lawyer for the accused prays for bail.

Ld. P.P. opposes the bail prayer.

Considered the submissions made by both the sides. Perused the T.C.R., F.I.R and CD. The FIR of the instant case has been lodged after three years of the incident. It is a case of political rivalry. Considering the submission of both the sides, I am inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused petitioner be released, on furnishing bond of Rs.2000/- with one surety, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on compliance with the conditions as envisaged u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of. Return the C.D.
