This petition coming before me on this day for final hearing in the presence of learned Advocate Thiru.D.Manikandan, B.A., B.L., upon hearing arguments, perusing the records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this courts delivers the following,

ORDER

Heard. Perused.

1) The Petitioner is the accused in Cr No.575/2023 of Palancichettipatti P.S for the alleged offence U/s.294(b), 323, 506(i) of IPC and 4 of TNPHW Act.

2) Learned counsel for Petitioner has filed this petition, seeking for grant of bail U/S. 480 of BNSS. The Learned counsel for the Petitioner contented that the petitioner / accused is remanded on 22.06.2026. The accused will not tamper the

witness and the petitioner / accused is ready and willing to furnish substantial sureties and he is ready to abide any condition imposed by this court. Hence, the learned counsel prayed for the release of the Petitioner on bail.

3) Reply received.

4) The court gave thoughtful considerations to the rival submissions made by both the sides and upon perusal of records and submissions it is manifest that the accused is in the judicial custody for about 12 days since this date of remand on 22.06.2026.

5) On perusal of records, The petitioner / accused was produced on NBW on 22.06.2026 and has been in judicial custody since then. The petitioner / accused is ready to furnish the sureties. The petitioner / accused undertakes to abide by any conditions imposed by this Court. Hence, considering the circumstances and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner this Court is inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner.

6) Accordingly this bail petition is allowed and the Petitioner/Accused is released on bail on the following Conditions:-

- i.** The Petitioner/Accused shall execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for like sum.
- ii.** The photographs and left thumb impressions of the sureties be affixed in the surety bond, A copy of their Aadhar Card / Voter ID card / Bank Pass Book of the sureties be furnished for their identity, The phone numbers of the sureties and of the Petitioner / Accused be furnished.
- iii.** The Petitioner/Accused shall appear before this Court every friday at 10.00 A.M. until disposal of the case.
- iv.** The Petitioner/Accused shall abide by the condition as contemplated U/s 482 BNSS.

- v. In case of any violation of the above conditions, the Respondent/Police shall be at liberty to take action as per the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K. Shaji Vs State of Kerala AIR 2005 SCR 5560.
