ORDER

1. The petitioner/accused had filled this Petition under Section 480 of BNSS seeking Bail for the offence Under Section.465, 468, 471, 420 IPC r/w 12(1)(b) of Passport Act.
2. The Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submit that, the petitioner/accused was remanded to Judicial Custody on 09.07.2026 on the execution of Non Bailable Warrant and that, the petitioner/accused has been in custody for till date and that, herein after petitioner/accused would attend the Court regularly.
3. The Learned Additional Public Prosecutor Mrs.V.Amutha., appearing for the prosecution vehemently opposed this application on the ground that, the accused would again abscond and trial would be delayed and further he is a history sheet and hence his bail application deserves dismissal.
4. This court had carefully considered the rival submissions of the both parties. Records were perused carefully. It is notice that this petitioner/accused is habitually absconding himself and upon NBW issued is recalling the same on account of which trial is prolonged inordinately for a period of near by 13 years. Hence, this court is not inclined to allow this petition.

In the result, the bail petition is dismissed.
