This petition came up on this day for final hearing before me in the presence of Tmt.Kavya, Learned APP for the petitioner/complainant and respondent/surety appeared in person and upon hearing both sides and perusing the records, this Court passed the following...

ORDER

This petition is filed under sec. 446 Cr.P.C praying to forefiet the surety.

2. The averments in the petition in brief:

This Case has been taken up by this court in Crime No. 723/2013 in P.R.C. No.12/2019. The accused Veerasureshsingh is on bail. The accused Veerasureshsingh has not appeared before this court and this court issued a Non-Bailable Warrant against the accused and the same was pending before this court for long days. Hence notice has been issued to the respondent/surety who assured the accused's appearance.



On receipt of the notice, the 2nd surety appeared before this court and stated that the 1st surety had died, and he sought time for the production of the accused. This court considered the request of the respondent/surety and granted time for the respondent.

Records perused. The respondent/surety had given assurance of the appearance of the accused before this court and also executed the bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/-. This court granted sufficient time to the respondent/surety. However, the respondent/surety did not produce the accused and also did not give sufficient explanations and the surety requested the court to reduce the bond amount.

In the result the respondent/surety is directed to pay the bond amount of Rs.5,000/- to this court and in default the respondent/surety has to be detained in civil prison for 15 days.
