The cognizance of the offence is already taken by the Virtual Court. A fine was proposed for summary disposal of case as per section 208 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. The violator has exercised option to contest the challan on web portal of virtual traffic courts and the challan is transferred to this court for further adjudication as per law.

Vakalatanama has been filed on the official Email-Id of this Court.

Same is taken on record.

Violator is apprised about the challan against his which is U/s 112/183 of the Motor Vehicles Act i.e., Overspeeding of the LMV.

He wishes to plead guilty for offence U/s 112/183 of the Motor Vehicles Act and prays for a lenient view.

Violator is apprised about the consequences of pleading guilty and the fact that violator can be convicted for the offence. He submits that he has understood the consequences and wants to plead guilty.

Keeping in view the plea of guilt of offence, the violator is convicted for offence U/s 112/183 of the Motor Vehicles Act and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- by way of payment on online portal and in default Simple Imprisonment of 02 days.

Ld. counsel is directed to pay the fine imposed through online portal which has been shared with the violator.
