This petition is filed by the Learned Advocate Thiru. K.Ajmal Khan. After considering the petition and the reply given by Inspector of police, this court delivers the following

ORDER

1. This petition for bail has been filed by the petitioner/accused U/S.480, BNSS stating that the petitioner is falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner was remanded to Judicial custody on 19.03.2026 for the offence U/S. 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(3) BNS & 4 of TNPHW Act. The petitioner is ready to abide by any condition that may be imposed by this court. Hence, the accused may be released on bail.
2. The prosecution submitted the reply stating that in this case the accused is involved. Further, it was submitted that if the petitioner/Accused is let on bail, he may abscond and commit the offence again and he may also tamper and hamper the witness. Further, it was submitted that the investigation is yet to be completed and a charge sheet is to be filed.
3. Perused the available records. Both side arguments heard. The prosecution has raised strong objection to the bail. Stating that investigation is not completed.
4. The petitioner/Accused has been arrested and remanded to judicial custody for



past 12 days. The petitioner/accused has no previous case and the injured is discharged from the hospital. Hence, on considering the circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the accused in bail on following conditions;

- i. The petitioner/accused shall produce two sureties each for Rs.10,000/- and shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond.
- ii. The petitioner/accused shall sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 AM for the period of 30 days from the date of release.
- iii. Then the Petitioner/Accused shall co-operate the investigation and directed to appear before the respondent police station as and when required.
- iv. The petitioner/Accused shall not abscond during investigation/trial and shall cooperate for investigation.
- v. The petitioner/Accused shall not tamper with evidence or witness.
- vi. The petitioner should produce copy of the permanent address proof.
- vii. The petitioner shall not try to contact, influence, threaten or pressurize the victim or complainant or other material witnesses and shall not tamper with the evidence.
- viii. The petitioner shall not involve any similar kind of offence in future.
- ix. The Petitioner/Accused shall not get unnecessary adjournment during examination of witness and cross examine the witness without fail.
- x. If the petitioner/ Accused violate any of above conditions, the bail will be canceled in accordance with law.
