This petition is filed by the Learned Counsel Thiru.C.Maheshwaran. Upon considering the petition, this Court delivers the following

ORDER

1. This petition for bail has been filed by the petitioner/Accused under Section 478 / 480 of the BNSS, stating that the petitioner was remanded to Judicial custody on 16.06.2026 in execution of Warrant. Further the 1st bail petition was dismissed on 24.06.2026. The petitioner is a law abiding citizen and so he will not abscond. Further, the petitioner is ready to abide by any condition that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, the petitioner seeks to be released on bail.

2. On perusal of records, it is found that this accused has been remanded in execution of NBW issued in STC.No.277/2025. In DVC.No.24/2022, this accused has been directed to pay the monthly maintenance and compensation. But he failed to pay anything in the arrears. Now the arrears is nearly Rs.7 Lakh. Further, this petitioner does not come forward to pay anything in the arrears of maintenance. In such a view of the matter, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this bail petition stands dismissed.
