

ORDER BELOW Ex-1

The Claimant and **opponent No. 2** have arrived at a settlement in National Lok - Adalat, and the settlement is in the shape of a compromise pursis filed by the advocate for the claimant on behalf of claimant produced on the record at **Ex- 59**. The parties have no objection if the award is passed in terms of the compromise pursis. In these facts and circumstances, following final order is passed.

ORDER

- [1] The award for total **Rs. 2,11,000/-** (**Rs. Two Lacs Eleven Thousand Only**) in terms of the compromise pursis **Ex- 59** is ordered to be drawn up herein.
 - [2] This matter has been settled in National Lok - Adalat, therefore the claimant is exempted to pay Court Fees Under Sec. 21(1) of Legal Services Authorities Act 1987. So it is not required to recover Court Fees.
 - [3] Out of the said amount applicant no. 1 would be entitled to get 70 % and applicant no. 2 is entitled to get 30 %.
 - [4] Out of the aforesaid amount, the NFL amount if already paid to the applicant, if any be deducted and the remaining amount be paid to applicant **50%** of the amount be paid to the claimants by account payee cheque, and remaining **50%** amount be invested in the name of the claimants in fixed deposit scheme in any nationalized bank as per the choice of claimant for a period of **five** years.
 - [5] The Bank shall not allow any loan or advances or create any encumbrance upon fix deposit receipt without previous permission of this tribunal.
 - [6] There shall be no order as to costs.
