Petition filed u/s.430(1)of BNSS for Suspension of sentence to prefer an appeal.

This petition is come before me for hearing in the presence of Learned Advocate Mr.M.Chandran for petitioner and Learned Advocate Mr.S.Maruthu pandian for respondent and having stood over consideration and this court made following

ORDER

1. The petitioner is convicted and sentenced to undergo to simple imprisonment for the period of **3 Months** and also directed to pay sum of **Rs.3,00,000/-** to the complainant as compensation u/s.395(3) of Cr.P.C. for an offence u/s.138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

2. The petitioner submitted that he intend to prefer an appeal against the Judgment passed by this court. Further the petitioner prayed to enlarge him on bail to prefer an appeal. Further the petitioner submitted that he is ready to produce substantial sureties for his bail.

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3. The petitioner is being on bail and sentenced to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 years. Further the offence under section 138 of N.I.Act is compoundable and also bailable in nature. Further the appeal is the right of the person accused.

4. Considering the facts and circumstance of the case and also the period of sentence is less than three years. Hence, the sentence alone temporarily suspended till 29.06.2026 in the interest of Justice.

In the result the petition is allowed.
