This petition came up for final hearing before this Court on 04.03.2025, in the presence of Mr.R.Balasingam, Learned Counsel for the petitioner/6th accused and Mr.B.Sivakumar, Additional Public Prosecutor/Learned Counsel for the

respondent/complainant and upon perusing the Petition, Reply and Documents and upon hearing both sides arguments and having stood over for consideration till this day, this Court delivered the following...

ORDER

The petition filed by the Petitioner/6th accused Periyakulam Police Station, Crime No. 115/2023 (under sections 147, 148, 294(b), 342, 302 and 149 IPC) for seeking relaxation of conditions in the order passed in CrI.M.P.No.17/2026.

2. The Learned Counsel for petitioner/6th accused argued that, the petition seeking relaxation of conditions imposed in Periyakulam Police Station, Crime No. 115/2023, (Under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 342, 302 and 149 IPC) as per the order passed in Cr-I.M.P.No.17/2026, the petitioner has to appear in person at the Thiruvarur District, Kudavasal police station daily at 10.00 am and continue to sign until further orders, and the said petitioner has signed for 30 days from 31.01.2026 to 01.03.2026, the petitioner is a law abiding person and will not tamper the witnesses, and the petitioner has sought relaxation of the conditions imposed in CrI.M.P.No.17/2026 against the petitioner.

3. Whereas, the Learned Counsel/Additional Public Prosecutor has argued that, the petitioner has appeared in person at the Kudavasal police station every day from 31.01.2026 to 01.03.2026 at 10.00 am has signed, and a strong objection has been raised to the relaxation of the conditions for the said petitioner.

4. Heard both sides. Record perused. The petitioner as continuously appearing before the Thiruvarur District, Kudavasal police station for about 30 days. Having considered the compliance the bail condition imposed on the petitioner is totally relaxed.

In the result, the petition is allowed the condition imposed upon the petitioner by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.17/2026 dated 12.01.2026 is totally relaxed.
