The petition coming for final hearing before me the petitioners counsel Mr. P.Ganesan, B.A.,B.L., Advocate and the respondent Police through Assistant Public Prosecutor and after hearing the arguments of both sides and on perusal of case records, this court delivered the following.

ORDER

1) Bail application filed u/s 480 of BNSS Act for an alleged offence punishable under section 4(1)(C), 4(1)(A) of TNP Amendment Act 2024.

2) The petitioner produced before this court and remanded to Judicial custody on 02.07.2026. The learned petitioner counsel argued that the petitioner didn't commit any such offence as alleged by this prosecution and the defacto complainant has given false complaint against the petitioner and he will obey any stringent condition for his bail and also argued that the petitioner is under judicial custody for the past 03 days. Hence seeks bail.

3) On perusal of the case records prosecution represent that, If the petitioner is released on bail he may tamper the witnesses and abscond he will not appear before

this court . Hence the prosecution objects to release the petitioner on bail. Hence, opposed released him on bail.

4) Considering the nature of the case and gravity of offence, the accused have 21 previous cases, therefore this court not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Therefore this bail application is hereby dismissed.

Accordingly this petition is dismissed.
