Honorable HIGH COURT OF MADRAS in Criminal Appeal No. 663 of 2016 -Chinnathambi alies Subramani vs. State represented by the Inspector of Police, Vellakovil Police Station,Tiruppur District.held as follows The power of the Magistrate under Section 173(8) Cr.P.C. to permit further investigation is an independent power, and its exercise does not amount to varying, modifying, or cancelling the earlier order of the Magistrate, whether judicial or administrative. For seeking permission for further investigation under Section 173(8) Cr.P.C., the earlier order of the Magistrate, whether judicial or administrative, need not be challenged before a higher forum. Therefore, it is clear that it is not difficult for the Police or Investigating Officer to reopen the case for further investigation if any fresh or additional material surfaces, or if any aggrieved person or material witness approaches with sufficient evidence. The Investigating Officer himself may conduct further investigation. In view of the same, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the case pending. Hence, the Referred Charge Sheet is accepted and the case is closed

accordingly.
