Suit for partition and separate possession, restraining the defendants, their men, agents, etc. from in any way and in any manner either trespassing into the suit properties or disturbing the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit property by the plaintiff by means of permanent injunction, for partition and division of the suit properties described in the schedule below in to two equal shares by metes and bounds with reference to good and bad soil and allot one such contiguous shares to the plaintiff, directing the defendant to put the plaintiff in separate possession of their shares so allotted and the plaintiff the costs of the suit.
