This petition came before me on 20.02.2025 for final hearing in the presence of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, and on the side of the accused he himself appeared in person. After hearing the arguments of learned APP and on perusal of the petition filed by the petitioner/accused and considering the reply filed by the respondent this court delivered the following :

// ORDER //

1. The petitioner is the accused in this case. The case of the prosecution is on the date of occurrence when the defacto complainant returned from the hospital after seeing this husband and son who met with an accident. At the time, the accused was enquired by Dinesh Kumar, at that time the accused came with a iron rod and threatened the defacto complainant and Gomathi Rani and attacked the said Gomathi Rani by using the iron rod and stolen, hand bag with cash of Rs.500/- ATM and Bank cards.

2. After the committal proceedings the case was made over to this Court and after framing of charges now the case is in the stage of further prosecution witness. In, open Court the accused submitted the bail application for consideration. The learned APP strongly opposed this application on the ground, the accused is belonged to other district and if he is granted bail there is a chance for abscond. So, he asked this Court to dismiss the petition. In the reply, the respondent police also stated the accused is a habitual offender and he is having more than 5 cases in Nallur and Anupparpalayam Police Station. If the accused is released on bail he will tamper the evidence and again he will commit the same kind of offence and asked to dismiss the same.

3. On perusal of records, the accused is in Judicial Custody from 02.12.2023. The case is now in part heard stage. Hence, considering the circumstances, remand period and the accused is in Judicial Custody from the date of arrest in interest of justice this Court

hereby inclined to grant bail to the accused with the following conditions :-

1. The petitioner is directed to execute a bond for Rs.20,000/- with two sureties and the petitioner is directed to produce the copy of his permanent address.

2. The sureties are directed to produce a copy of ID proof.

3. The petitioner/accused is directed to appear on all hearings and on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of every month before this Court until further orders.
