Petition filed U/s 497 and 503 of BNSS Act to return the case property.

This petition is filed on 09.03.2026 by the petitioner party in person for interim custody of the case property. Notice issued to learned APP and concerned SHO. Upon considering the case records this court delivers the following.

ORDER

The petition is filed by the petitioner Under section 497 and 503 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to return the case property An Amount Rs.5000/- seized in connection with Cr.No.928/2025 registered U/s.308(2) of BNS of Palladam, Police station.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner herein and the defacto complainant of Palladam, Police station Cr.No.928/2025. The petition mentioned property was stolen by some criminals. The petitioner immediately lodged a complaint before Palladam,Police station which is registered as Cr.No.928/2025. The police investigated and arrested the culprits. Now police seized petition mentioned property from the culprits. The petition mentioned properties are absolutely belongs to the petitioner and the petitioner is owner of the same. Unless the petition mentioned property are handed over to the petitioner as interim custody The petitioner will be put to very loss and hardship. The petitioner undertake to produce this said properties whenever this Hon'ble court orders to produce.

3.Heard Both sides, Records perused.This court carefully perused the complaint, The case property of An Amount Rs.5000/-was kept in respondent police station.

There is no dispute regarding the ownership of property. Hence on considering the facts and circumstances of this case. Considering the petitioner is the ownership of the case property. Upon considering the Hon'ble Supreme court Verdicts guidelines held " In Re sundar Bai ambalal Vs. State this court is of view to handover the case property of An Amount Rs.5000/- seized as interim custody to the petitioner with following conditions.

i)The petitioner shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- to the satisfaction of this court.

ii)The petitioner shall submit the photographs of the property from four dimension and to be certified U/s. 63 BSA.

iii)The petitioner shall execute the Panchanama in judicial Form No.82 in accordance with law.

iv)The petitioner should be identified by the petitioner counsel and the Investigation Officer.

Accordingly this petition is allowed.
