Petition filed U/s. 480 BNSS to release the accused on bail.

This petition was filed online on 01.06.2026 by the counsel for the petitioner MrR.Prabhakaran, Advocate, for the petitioner and Learned APP filed objection for the Respondent and upon perusal of case records and on merits this court delivers the following.

ORDER

The petitioner/Accused is seeking bail for the offence alleged to have been committed by him.U/s.126(2),296(b),309(6),311 and 351(3) BNS in Cr.No.93/2026 of Avinashipalayam, Police Station.

2.The Learned counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner did not commit any offense as alleged by the complainant. The respondent has foisted a false case against the petitioner based on the twisted facts concocted by the defacto complainant. He did not commits any offences mentioned in the complainant nor FIR. The Respondent/ Defacto complainant has registered a case against the petitioner without any basis. The petitioner further submits that the investigation was almost completed. The offense mentioned in the FIR do not attract the ingredients of the charges. The defacto complainant has falsely logged a complainant against the petitioner. The petitioner has not filed any previous bail petition before this Hon'ble court. The petitioner is the only breadwinner of his family He is an innocent person who did not commit any offences filed the Respondent/ defacto complainant. The petitioner is a law abiding citizen and he will abide by any

condition imposed by this Hon'ble Court. The petitioner is ready to execute bond and also ready to comply with any order to the satisfaction of this Hon'ble court for grant of bail.

3.The respondent filed reply and submitted that the investigation in this case has been completed, and a charge sheet was filed against the accused on 06.05.2026. The same has been taken on file as C.C.No.209/2026, and the case is presently pending. If the Petitioner/ Accused is released on bail he will commit similar offence at various place and create law and order problems. Even he will even try to abscond to some other place and it will be difficult for police to secure him. Even he will try to tamper the investigation. Hence the prosecution side strongly opposed to release the accused on bail.

4. Records perused. On Perusal of materials placed on records, it would disclosed that the Petitioner/Accused was remanded to Judicial custody on 17.03.2026 for the past 83 days. The Goondas Proceedings initiated against the accused have been revoked and proceedings No.3011/2026 has been duly filed. Hence on considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offence. He is assured for co-operation in investigation and trial, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner/ Accused on bail subject to following conditions.

5.In the result the Petitioner/Accused is ordered to be released on bail on their execution of bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- and the Petitioner/Accused shall produce two sureties in that one surety must be a close relative (blood relative)

- i) The petitioner shall sign before Respondent police station at 10.00 Am and 5.30 pm for until further order
- ii) The petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness during trial.
- iii) The petitioner shall not abscond either investigation or during trial.
- iv) The petitioner shall not indulge any other criminal activities.
- v) If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR may be filed U/s. 269 BNSS as per direction rendered in P.K. Shaji Vs State of Kerala reported in (2005) AIR SCW 5560.
- vi) The petitioner/Accused shall appear before this court on Summons.

Accordingly, the bail petition is allowed.
