Petition filed U/s.483(1)(b) BNSS to condition modification is relaxed or suitably modified.

This petition was filed online on 06.06.2026 by petitioner counsel Thiru. A.Rajesh, and Learned APP filed objection for the Respondent and upon perusal of case records and on merits this court delivers the following.

ORDER

The petitioner/Accused is seeking U/s 483(1)(b) of BNSS to the condition modification is relaxed or suitably modified.

2.The Learned counsel for the petitioner/accused would submit that this Hon'ble Court enlarged bail to the petitioner in Crl. M.P. No. 229 of 2026 on 11.05.2026 with condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station on daily at 10.00 am until further orders. The Petitioner/ Accused submits that the petitioners observed the condition in Crl.M.P. No. 229 of 2026 regularly for the past 25 days without fail. The petitioner is regularly abide the said condition for the past 25 days and the petitioner is a coolie worker and taking care of he family and because to abide the condition he is appearing before the respondent police station on daily at 10.00 am, only if the condition is relaxed the petitioner/ accused will be able take care of family. The Petitioner/ Accused undertakes that she is an innocent person and she having her permanent residence at the above address and he will not abscond and not evade the Prosecution witnesses. The Petitioner undertakes to appear before this Hon'ble Court in future hearings without fail. Unless the condition is relaxed the

Petitioner will be put to untold sufferings and great hardship. The Petitioner/ Accused submit that there is no similar petition or any other applications are pending before the Honourable High Court of Judicature at Madras.

3.The respondent filed reply and submitted that the Accused is signing at Kamanaickenpalayam, Police Station on 14.05.2026 to till date as per the Order of this court in Crlmp.No.229/2026 Dated.13.05.2026. If the accused is granted conditional bail, there is a possibility that the accused will abscond without appearing in court. Therefore, granting relaxation in conditional bail is objectionable and this petition required to be dismissed.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused and the learned APP for the state and also perused the entire materials available on record it reveals that the accused was complied condition of signing at 10.00Am at police station everyday. And undertake for the compliance of all the other condition in bail order without any default. The petition for relaxation of the condition of reporting and signing before the respondent Police Station everyday is found to be tenable under the circumstances. Accordingly, this petition is allowed, and the condition imposing **daily attendance/signing at the Police Station** is modified so that the accused shall instead appear and sign before respondent police station once every fifteen days for a period of three months.

5. In fine this petition is allowed and relaxed the condition.
