This petition has come up on 26.11.2025 for final hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.. R.S. Prabhakaran B.A., B.L., learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner/Complainant and Thiru.P. Vadivelsamy B.A., B.L., learned counsel appearing for the Respondent/Accused and upon hearing both side and upon perusal of the records, this court delivers the following:

ORDER

1. The petitioner has filed this application seeking to implead (1) R. Kausalya K/P. Raja and (2) Sri Pon Azhugwu Exports Company as additional

respondents in the cheque fraud case. The petitioner submits that the partnership documents and registration certificate filed by the respondent during the pendency of the case reveal that the proposed parties are directly connected with the disputed transaction and are necessary for full adjudication.

2. The respondent opposes the petition, contending that the case has already been fully heard and closed for judgment, and that the proposed parties were not mentioned in the original notice. The respondent denies that the proposed parties are shareholders or partners in the manner claimed by the petitioner and submits that impleading them at this stage is unnecessary.

3. Heard both sides. Records perused. In the interest of justice, the Court finds that impleading the proposed parties is necessary to ensure complete adjudication of the case. Mere impleading will not cause any undue hardship to the respondent.

4. The petitioner shall pay a cost of Rs. 500/- to the respondent for the delay in filing this petition.
