This petition coming before me in the presence of the learned counsel for Petitioner Mr.K.Ragul, B.A., B.L., and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-II and upon hearing both side. On perusing the materials records and having stood over for consideration till date, this Court delivers the following ;

**ORDER**  
**(480 of BNSS)**

1. Heard and perused the records. The learned counsel stated that the petitioner/1st accused was remanded in Judicial custody on 19.02.2026. Further the petitioner have appeared before the Hon'ble Judicial Magistrate No.3 of Dindigul in CC No.64/2026 and on that date the police officials have took him into custody and brought him to Udumalpet and put up this offence over him which he haven't committed the offences as alleged and the complainant side failed to investigate the case properly and he is innocent and has not committed any offences as alleged, he is ready to produce sufficient sureties to satisfaction of this court and he is ready to abide by any condition to be imposed by this court. Hence the 1<sup>st</sup> accused may be released on bail.

2. The respondent police has strongly objected to enlarge the accused on bail contending that the 1<sup>st</sup> accused/petitioner is already involved in 1.Madurai District Oomachikulam PS in Cr.No.40/2023, 2.Mattuthavani PS Cr.No.251/2023, 3.Thallakulam PS Cr.No.1240/2021, 4.Appanthirupathi PS Cr.No.92/2023. 5.Madurai City K. Pudur PS Cr.No.555/2025, 6.Cr.No.218/2023, 7.Cr.No.417/2022, 8.Coimbatore District Chettipalayam PS Cr.No.88/2024, 9.Thanjavur District Thilahr Thidal PS Cr.No.573/2024, 10.Thirividaimarudhur PS Cr.No.859/2024, 11.Tiruppur District Avinasipalayam PS Cr.No.96/2024, 12.Dindugul District PS Cr.No.227/2025 and the 1<sup>st</sup> accused may be absconded, if enlarged on bail, there is a chance of committing the same offence and steps are being taken by the District Collector of Tiruppur to invoke the preventive detention provisions under the Goondas Act against the accused and there is a possibility that the accused may abscond and prayed for dismissal of the petition. Likewise the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-II has very strongly objected this petition by submitting that the case investigation is pending and the petitioner may tamper the witnesses and the accused is very grave in nature.

3. Perused the available records. The petitioner is the 4<sup>th</sup> accused in Cr.No.88/2026 of Udumalpet Police Station in respect of offence U/s. 304(2) of BNS Act. The accused has been in judicial custody from 19.02.2026 till date for the past 20 days and the case is pending under investigation. On considering the nature of offence and fact and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the bail up on following conditions;

**Conditions:**

1. The petitioner/1st accused shall execute their own bond and shall produce two sureties for executing bond for like a sum of Rs.10,000/- each and the petitioner shall submit a copy of his identity card.
2. The petitioner shall appear and sign before this Court daily at 10.00 A.M. until further orders.

3. The petitioner shall not abscond during investigation / trail.
4. The petitioner shall not commit offences of any similar nature.
5. The petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness.
6. If the petitioner changed his address, they must inform to the police station.
