**ORDER**

This petition has been filed by the petitioner Under Section 483 (1) (b) BNSS Act, 2023 for relaxation of the condition imposed by this court in **Cr.M.P.No.45/ 2026; Dated 12.01.2026.**

The petitioner is the Accused in Crime No.791/2025 before respondent police for the alleged offences u/s. 110, 281 of BNS and u/s.185 of MV Act, 1988 and he was enlarged on Bail by this court in

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner is complying the condition daily once for the past **47 days**.

In contra, the learned Public Prosecutor would raise objection through a report of concern police by stating that if the conditions are fully relaxed, the petitioner will abscond and tamper the witnesses and will not appear for trial and hence, sought to dismiss the petition.

Both side heard. Records perused. The petitioner was enlarged on Bail by this court in Cr.M.P.No.45/2026 Dated 12.01.2026 with direction to appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders. The petitioner is complying with condition promptly without any deviation for the past **47 days**. As per the report of concern police, the major portion of investigation might have been completed by considering the date of occurrence and the First Information Report.

By considering the facts and circumstances and stage of the case, this court **is inclined** to totally relax the conditions imposed by this court in **Cr.M.P.No.45/2026; Dated: 12.01.2026**.

In the result, this Petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioners / accused by this court in **Cr.M.P.No.45/2026; Dated: 12.01.2026** is totally relaxed and the other conditions remains the same.
