This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.R.Prabhakaran, Advocate for the petitioner and Thiru.S.Kanagasabapathy, Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing both side and upon perusing the documents, this court delivers the following;

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner to relax the condition imposed by this court in **Cr.M.P.No.1192/2025; Dated: 15.05.2025.**

The petitioner is the Accused in Crime No.535/2024 before respondent police for the alleged offences U/s.303 (2) of BNS and he was enlarged on Bail by this court in Cr.M.P.No.268/2025, Dated:30.01.2025 with direction to appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders. Further, the petitioner had filed a petition to modify the said condition in Cr.M.P.No.1192/2025 and the same was allowed on 15.05.2025 by directing the petitioner to appear and sign before

the District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Uthukuli once in a week on every Monday at 10.00 a.m until further orders.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner is complying the condition as once in a week for 27 number of time.

In contra, the Public Prosecutor would raise objection through a report of concern police by stating that if the conditions are fully relaxed, the petitioner will abscond and tamper the witnesses and will not appear for trial and hence, sought to dismiss the petition.

Both side heard. Records perused. The petitioner was enlarged on Bail by this court in Cr.M.P.No.268/2025, Dated:30.01.2025 with direction to appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders. Further, the petitioner had filed a petition to modify the said condition in Cr.M.P.No.1192/2025 and the same was allowed on 15.05.2025 by directing the petitioner to appear and sign before the District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Uthukuli once in a week on every Monday at 10.00 a.m until further orders. The petitioner had complied the condition weekly once for 27 number of time. As per the report of concern police, the investigation was completed and final report was filed and taken up on file in C.C.No.11/2025 on the file of District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Uthukuli.

By considering the facts and circumstances, this court **is inclined** to totally relax the conditions imposed by this Court in **Cr.M.P. No.1192/2025; Dated: 15.05.2025**.

In the result, this Petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioner / accused by this Court in **Cr.M.P. No.1192/2025; Dated: 15.05.2025** is totally relaxed and the other conditions remains the same.
