This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.K.Sagadevan, Advocate for the petitioners and Thiru.S.Kanagasabapathy, Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing both side and upon perusing the documents, this court delivers the following;

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioners to relax the condition imposed by this court in **Cr.M.P.No.2618/2025; Dated: 28.10.2025.**

The petitioners are the Accused in Crime No.552/2025 before respondent police for the alleged offences u/s.296(b), 115(2), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS and they were enlarged on Bail by this court in Cr.M.P.No.2239/2025, Dated:09.09.2025 with direction to appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders. Further, the petitioners had filed a petition to modify the said condition in Cr.M.P.No.2618/2025 and the same was allowed on 28.10.2025 by directing the petitioners to appear and sign before the respondent Police Station once in a week on every Monday at 10.00 a.m until further orders.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners/accused would submit that the petitioners are complying the condition as once in a week for **17** number of time.

In contra, the Public Prosecutor would raise objection through a report of concern police by stating that if the conditions are fully relaxed, the petitioners will abscond and tamper the witnesses and will not appear for trial and hence, sought to dismiss the petition.

Both side heard. Records perused. The petitioners were enlarged on Bail by this court in Cr.M.P.No.2239/2025, Dated:09.09.2025 with direction to appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders. Further, the petitioners had filed a petition to modify the said condition in Cr.M.P.No.2618/2025 and the same was allowed on 28.10.2025 by directing the petitioners to appear and sign before the respondent Police Station once in a week on every Monday at 10.00 a.m until further orders. The petitioners are complying with condition promptly without any deviation once in a week for **17 number** of time. The investigation is completed and final report is also filed and taken up on file in C.C.No.634/2025 on the file of Judicial Magistrate, Kangeyam.

By considering the facts and circumstances, this court **is inclined** to totally relax the conditions imposed by this Court in **Cr.M.P. No.2618/2025; Dated: 28.10.2025.**

In the result, this Petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioners / accused by this Court in **Cr.M.P. No.2618/2025; Dated: 28.10.2025** is totally relaxed and the other conditions remains the same.
