This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.M.Ramesh, Counsel for the petitioner and Thiru.S.Kanagasabapathy, Public Prosecutor for the respondent, after hearing both sides and on perusing the Reply submitted by the Respondent and the Records, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The Petitioner has filed the application U/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking bail for the offence u/s.304(2) of BNS in Cr.No.26/2026 of the respondent police.

First Information Report is pending against the petitioner u/s. 304(2) of BNS. The alleged date of occurrence is on 04.02.2026 and First Information Report was registered and the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on the very same day and he is in incarceration for **past 35 days.**

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

In contra, the Public Prosecutor would raise objection through a report of concern police by stating that the petitioner alleged to have snatched a gold Mangal Sutra weighing six sovereigns in total from the defacto complainant who is aged about 65 years and hence, sought to dismiss the application.

Both side heard. Records perused. The alleged date of occurrence is on 04.02.2026 and First Information Report was registered and the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on the very same day and he is in incarceration for **past 35 days**. As per the report of concern police, the investigation is in progress.

By considering the facts and circumstances, nature and gravity of offence, stage of the investigation and the manner in which the offence alleged to have taken place, this court **is not inclined** to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

In the result, this petition **is dismissed**.
