These petitions came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.A.Mohamed Imran, Counsel for the petitioners and Thiru.S.Kanagasabapathy, Public Prosecutor for the State / respondent, after hearing both sides and on perusing the Reply submitted by the Respondent and the Records, this Court delivers the following:

COMMON ORDER

The Petitioners have filed the application U/s.482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail for the offence u/s.115(2), 118(1), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act @ 109(1), 115(2), 118(1), 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act in Cr.No.22/2026 of the respondent police.

First Information Report is pending against the petitioners u/s.115(2), 118(1), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act @ 109(1), 115(2), 118(1), 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act. The alleged date of occurrence is on 27.01.2026 and First Information Report was registered on the very same day.

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

In contra, the learned Public Prosecutor would raise objection through a report of concern police by stating that out of property dispute, there arose a scuffle in between the parties, as a result, person including the defacto complainant alleged to have sustained injury out of abusement on criminal intimidation from the petitioners and the other accused on the date of occurrence and hence, sought to dismiss the application.

Both side heard. Records perused. The alleged date of occurrence is on 27.01.2026 and First Information Report was registered on the very same day. As per the report of concern police, no other previous case is

pending against the petitioners. The injured were discharged from hospital. Admittedly, there exist a case in counter against the defacto complainant and others with the respondent police in Crime No.21/2026 u/s.191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 49 of BNS, Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (POA) Amendment Act, 2015 and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act and the anticipatory bail sought by the accused therein viz. Aswin was allowed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras vide order in CrI.O.P.No.2781 /2026; dated: 06.02.2026 and bail sought by the accused therein viz.Dharmaraj, Dhayanandan and Saranya were dismissed by the Special Court for Trial of Cases under SC/ST (POA) Act, Tiruppur vide order in Cr.M.P.No.11/2026, dated:12.02.2026 and Cr.M.P.No.16/2026, dated:23.02.2026 and on against the said dismissal order, they have preferred an appeal before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and numbered in CrI.A.No.215/2026 and CrI.A.No.248/2026 and the same were allowed on 18.03.2026, respectively. Further, the co-accused in this case viz. A5 and A8, A6, A7, A1 and A3, A10, A11 were already enlarged on bail by this court vide order in CrI.M.P.No.652/2026, dated: 27.03.2026 and CrI.M.P.No.716/2026, dated: 07.04.2026, CrI.M.P.No.675/2026, dated: 30.03.2026, CrI.M.P.Nos.729/2026 and 734/2026, dated: 08.04.2026 and CrI.M.P.No.849/2026m, dated:27.04.2026, respectively. Major portion of the investigation might have been completed by considering the date of occurrence and the First Information Report.

By considering the facts and circumstances, nature and gravity of the offence, enlargement of co-accused on bail by this court and enlargement

of accused in counter case by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, this court **is inclined** to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail on following conditions.

In the result, the petitioners shall in the event of arrest by the respondent police or on their surrender before the **District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Madathukulam** within 15 days from the date of this order, be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Madathukulam** and on further condition that;

2. If the petitioners fail to surrender themselves before the said Judicial Magistrate within the time stipulated, this order shall automatically cancelled;

3. The petitioners should appear and sign before the respondent police daily at about 10.00 A.M. until further orders.

4. The petitioners shall not tamper the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

5. The petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

6. On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by it as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]. If

the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under section 269 BNS.

Accordingly, the petitions in **Cr.M.P.No.1096/2026, Cr.M.P.No.1097/2026 and Cr.M.P.No.1098/2026** are **allowed**.
