This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.A.Bakthapiragalathan, Counsel for the petitioners and Thiru.S.Kanagasabapathy, Public Prosecutor for the State / respondent, after hearing both sides and on perusing the Reply submitted by the Respondent and the Records, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The Petitioners have filed the application U/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking bail for the offence u/s.103(1) and 315 of BNS in Cr.No.217/2026 of the respondent police.

First Information Report is pending against the petitioners u/s.103(1) @ 103(1) and 315 of BNS. The alleged date of occurrence is from 23.03.2026 to 24.03.2026 and First Information Report was registered on 24.03.2026 and the petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 25.03.2026 and they are in incarceration for **past 76 days**.

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

In contra, the learned Public Prosecutor would raise objection through a report of concern police by stating that the deceased was alleged to have mislead the girl friend of the first accused / 1st petitioner herein and as a result, the petitioners were collectively alleged to have murdered him by cut throat with an aid of knife and hence, sought to dismiss the application.

Both side heard. Records perused. The alleged date of occurrence is from 23.03.2026 to 24.03.2026 and First Information Report was registered on 24.03.2026 and the petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 25.03.2026 and they are in incarceration for the **past 76 days**. As per the report of concern police, the investigation is in progress.

By considering the facts and circumstances, nature and gravity of offence, stage of investigation and the manner in which the offence alleged to have taken place, this court **is not inclined** to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

In the result, this petition is **dismissed**.
