This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.P.Murugesan, Counsel for the petitioners and Thiru.S.Kanagasabapathy, Public Prosecutor for the State / respondent, after hearing both sides and on perusing the Reply submitted by the Respondent and the Records, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The Petitioners have filed the application U/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking bail for the offence u/s.296(b), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS @ 61, 296(b), 109(1) of BNS in Cr.No.172/2026 of the respondent police.

First Information Report is pending against the petitioners u/s.296(b), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS @ 61, 296(b), 109(1) of BNS. The alleged date of occurrence is on 16.05.2026 and First Information Report was registered on the very same day and the petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 02.06.2026 and they are in incarceration for **past 07 days**.

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

In contra, the learned Public Prosecutor would raise objection through a report of concern police by stating that out of dispute over the purchase of livestock, there arose a wordy quarrel in between the parties, as a result, the petitioners collectively alleged to have inflicted injury to the defacto complainant in an attempt to commit murder with an aid of weapon and hence, sought to dismiss the application.

Both side heard. Records perused. The alleged date of occurrence is on 16.05.2026 and First Information Report was registered on the very same day and the petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial

custody on 02.06.2026 and they are in incarceration for past **07 days**. The perusal of records including the copy of accident register would disclose multiple laceration wound and the offence is of grave in nature and the investigation is in progress as per the report of concern police.

By considering the facts and circumstances, nature and gravity of offence, stage of investigation, nature of injury and the manner in which the offence alleged to have taken place, this court **is not inclined** to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

In the result, this petition is **dismissed**.
