This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru. K.Mathan kumar, Counsel for the petitioners and upon hearing the petitioners' side and upon perusing the records including the objection in writing submitted by the Respondent police, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The Petitioners have filed the application U/s.482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail for the offence u/s.296(b), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS in Cr.No.319/2026 of the respondent police.

First Information Report is pending against the petitioners u/s.296(b), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS. The alleged date of occurrence is on 31.05.2026 and First Information Report was registered on 01.06.2026.

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

In contra, the respondent police would raise objection through a report by stating that out of altercation in between the parties at a liquor shop, the petitioners were collectively alleged to have assaulted the defacto complainant with an aid of weapon and caused injury on abusement and criminal intimidation and hence, sought to dismiss the application.

Heard. Records perused. The alleged date of occurrence is on 31.05.2026 and First Information Report was registered on 01.06.2026. The perusal of records including the copy of accident register would disclose that the defacto complainant was alleged to have sustained injury over the vital part of the body viz. Head and he was shown to have been admitted and treated as inpatient from 31.05.2026 to 16.06.2026. As per the report of concern police, the investigation is in progress.

By considering the above facts and circumstances, nature and gravity of offence, stage of investigation, nature of injury sustained by the injured and the manner in which the offence alleged to have taken place, this court **is not inclined** to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail.

In the result, this petition is **dismissed**.
