This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.R.Vikas, Advocate for the petitioners and upon hearing the petitioners' side and upon perusing the records including the objection in writing submitted by the Respondent police, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner to relax the condition imposed by this court in **Cr.M.P.No.468/2026; Dated: 03.03.2026.**

The petitioner is the Accused in Crime No.553/2025 before respondent police for the alleged offences u/s. 3(2)(a), 4(1), 4(2)(c) and 5(1)(d) of ITP Act, 1956 and he was enlarged on Bail by this Court in Cr.M.P.No.105/2026; Dated: 19.01.2026 with direction to appear and sign before the respondent Police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. Further, the petitioner had filed a petition to modify the said condition in Cr.M.P.No.468/2026 and the same was allowed on 03.03.2026 by directing

the petitioner to appear and sign before the respondent police once in a fortnight on every first upcoming Monday at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused would submit that the petitioner is complying the condition once in a fortnight for seven number of time.

In contra, the respondent police would raise objection through a report by stating that if the conditions are fully relaxed, the petitioner will abscond and tamper the witnesses and will not appear for trial and hence, sought to dismiss the petition.

Heard. Records perused. The petitioner was enlarged on Bail by this Court in Cr.M.P.No.105/2026; Dated: 19.01.2026 with direction to appear and sign before the respondent Police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. Further, the petitioner had filed a petition to modify the said condition in Cr.M.P.No.468/2026 and the same was allowed on 03.03.2026 by directing the petitioner to appear and sign before the respondent police once in a fortnight on every first upcoming Monday at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner is complying with condition promptly without any deviation once in a fortnight for seven number of time. Major portion of the investigation might have been completed by considering the date of occurrence and the First Information Report.

By considering the facts and circumstances, this court **is inclined** to totally relax the conditions imposed by this Court in **Cr.M.P.No.468/2026; Dated: 03.03.2026.**

In the result, this Petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioners / accused by this Court in **Cr.M.P.No.468/2026; Dated: 03.03.2026** is totally relaxed and the other conditions remains the same.
