This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru. C.Rajiv, Counsel for the petitioner and upon hearing the petitioner's side and upon perusing the records including the objection in writing submitted by the Respondent police, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The Petitioner has filed the application U/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking bail for the offence u/s.123, 275 of BNS and Section 20(2) of COTPA Act in Cr.No.591/2026 of the respondent police.

First Information Report is pending against the petitioner u/s.123, 275 of BNS and Section 20(2) of COTPA Act. The alleged date of

occurrence is on 23.06.2026 and First Information Report was registered and the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on the very same day and he is in incarceration for **past 9 days**.

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

In contra, the Respondent police would raise objection through a report by stating that the petitioner alleged to have been in illegal possession of 15 Kgs of banned tobacco products in order to sell the same to public at large to make an unlawful gain through illegal means and hence, sought to dismiss the application.

Heard. Records perused. The alleged date of occurrence is on 23.06.2026 and First Information Report was registered and the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on the very same day and he is in incarceration for **past 09 days**. As per the report of concern police, the investigation is in progress.

By considering the facts and circumstances, nature and gravity of offence, stage of investigation, quantity of banned tobacco products involved in the offence and interest of society at large, this court **is not inclined** to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

In the result, this petition is **dismissed**.
