This petition came for hearing on this day in the presence of Thiru.R.Selvam, Counsel for the petitioners and upon hearing the petitioners' side and upon perusing the records including the objection in writing submitted by the Respondent police, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The Petitioners have filed the application U/s.483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking bail for the offence u/s. 118(2), 296(b) and 351(3) of BNS in Cr.No.521/2026 of the respondent police.

First Information Report is pending against the petitioners u/s. 118(2), 296(b) and 351(3) of BNS. The alleged date of occurrence is on 09.06.2026 and First Information Report was registered on the very same day and the petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 10.06.2026 and they are in incarceration for **past 22 days**.

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners would contend that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

In contra, the respondent police would raise objection through a report by stating that out of wordy quarrel at the time of intake of liquor in a bar, the petitioners along with co-accused were collectively alleged to have assaulted the defacto complainant and inflicted injury with an aid of weapon and hence, sought to dismiss the application.

Heard. Records perused. The alleged date of occurrence is on 09.06.2026 and First Information Report was registered on the very same day and the petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 10.06.2026 and they are in incarceration for **past 22 days**. The perusal of records including the copy of accident register would disclose laceration wound over the vital part of the body viz. Head. As per the report of concern police, three and two other previous cases are pending against the petitioners No.1 and 2, respectively and the investigation is in progress.

By considering the facts and circumstances, nature and gravity of offence, stage of investigation, nature of injury, the manner in which the offence alleged to have taken place, antecedent of the petitioners and

interest of society at large, this court **is not inclined** to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

In the result, this petition **is dismissed**.
